
FLIGHT LEAGUE TAITA





Great value, well organised, FUN community school league.

Venue: Taita College Flight times: Thursday evening from 4.00pm

Aims: To promote sport and develop community connections, by providing innovative, affordable and sustainable basketball experiences to school children and youth in our wider community.

<u>Jet-Play Rules:</u> more game-time, less wasted time!

- Point-per-foul to promote good defense and reduce time lost to administering free-throws. No team foul or personal foul limit. Shooting fouls: 2-point shooting foul 1 point PLUS one FT 3-point shooting foul 2 points PLUS one FT Made basket foul basket value plus 1 point no need to shoot the And-1!
- Check ball to ref <u>only</u> in front court* to promote quick defensive transitions! (*except after foul)
- Rolling substitutions at any time, with "boarding pass"
- No timeouts! Let the players play! Use the quarter breaks to coach!
- No scoresheets required. Flipchart scoring is used.
- Clock stops for FTs only in last two minutes of 4th $\frac{1}{4}$.

Two Divisions are available in Term 4, 2023:

- Kāhu Division aimed at Yrs 7&8, beginners level
- Combat Division aimed at Yrs 8&9, more competent, advanced level.
- Times and divisions will be confirmed once entries are finalised. Indicative match lengths: 4 x 8 minute quarters

<u>Cost</u>: Special offer for Term Four, 2023: \$150 per team (8 weeks)

Flight League team-names: Each team entered will be assigned a "flight" name by Mission Control, such as a type of airplane (eg, Spitfire, Mustang, Predator). Draws will be posted using these names and school initials. This de-emphasises ultra-competitive school/college rivalries and promotes a spirit of young players simply enjoying their basketball, and helping to build constructive relationships in our wider community.

Other features of Flight League:

- Team Singlets not required (but can be worn!) Bibs/Singlets can be provided
- Competent, active refs assigned to each game FIBA rules enforced! That is, a
 travel is a travel, a foul is a foul. We want players to know how to play the game
 properly. Refs will actively correct players, so they understand why calls are
 made.
- Minimum of 3-minutes clear-court warm-up time for each match.
- No shot-clocks but referees will monitor as required.
- All games played with Size 6 basketball.
- "Hybrid Hoops" days offered when possible 3X3, 5v5 and Fastbreak Games.
- Match highlight video sent to each team/school.
